ORDINANCE NO. 2018-029

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2019 BUDGET FOR THE
TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO**

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has submitted to the Town Council the proposed 2019 Budget, in compliance with Section 9-4 of the Town's Home Rule Charter;

WHEREAS, a proper notice was published in accordance with Section 9-6 of the Charter for public hearing for the September 4, 2018 Town Council Meeting; and

WHEREAS, upon completion and review of the proposed budget, the Town Council is prepared to adopt a final budget for the calendar year 2019.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO**

Section 1. Adoption. The 2019 Budget, dated September 4, 2018, is approved and adopted, and therefore budgeted and appropriated by fund as follows:

Section 2. Compliance. The 2019 Budget, as approved and adopted, complies with Article IX of the Charter, and the total budgeted and appropriated expenditures and provisions for contingencies do not exceed the total of budgeted and appropriated revenues.

Section 3. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance.






