

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-092

A RESOLUTION NAMING OF THE MEADOWS FILING NO. 18 NEIGHBORHOOD
PARK THE DEPUTY ZACK S. PARRISH III MEMORIAL PARK

WHEREAS, Zackari S. Parrish III faithfully served the Douglas County Sheriff's Office and the Castle Rock Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Parrish was killed in the line of duty on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, community outreach was conducted to gather feedback on the name for the Meadows Filing No. 18 neighborhood park; and

WHEREAS, the community submitted over 700 suggestions for the park's name, and 77 percent of the suggestions submitted preferred the name to honor Parrish; and

WHEREAS, the Town's facility-naming policy provides that the goal for selecting names shall be fostering a sense of community, including names that heighten awareness of Town history and/or call attention to people, events and geography that have shaped the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town staff naming committee and the Parks and Recreation Commission have recommended that the park in The Meadows Filing 18 be named for Parrish; and

WHEREAS, Parrish's family has expressed their preference that the park be named the "Deputy Zack S. Parrish III Memorial Park," should the Council approve the recommendation to name the park to honor Parrish.

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Castle Rock as follows:

Section 1. The Meadows Filing No. 18 neighborhood park is hereby named the "Deputy Zack S. Parrish III Memorial Park."


Section 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


