The Town of Castle Rock is providing rebates to encourage residents to upgrade their old controllers with new weather-based technology. These state-of-the-art irrigation controllers, called Smart, ET or Evapotranspiration controllers, can conserve water, save money and reduce runoff by automating landscape watering based on the weather and water needs of plants. To take advantage of the rebate participants must attend a **Water Wiser Workshop** and meet all program requirements. The workshop covers Castle Rock's water supply, water system, efficient irrigation methods and fundamentals of water conservation with a focus on landscaping practices. Contact the Town of Castle Rock Utilities Department, 720-733-6000 or visit www.CRgov.com/utilities, for class information.

This program provides Castle Rock customers with a rebate to offset the purchase of a new irrigation controller. The rebate amount is 50 percent of the cost of the controller, up to \$300 (maximum). In order to participate, residents must possess a fully operational automatic irrigation system. This is a one-time rebate per service location. For program details, see the application form.

- I understand participants are limited to receiving a one-time SMART Controller rebate per household.
- [I understand that rebates will be processed in the order they are received, and that this offer is limited by available funding. I further understand that processing of my rebate may take between three \(3\) to six \(6\) weeks following Town issuance of Rebate Confirmation Notice.](#)
- I understand the program will reimburse me for half of the cost of the controller, up to \$300. Installation costs are not covered.
- I understand that the controller must be new and meet qualifying criteria. I further understand that the qualified controller must be purchased and installed at the address listed after January 1, 2009 (or the current year).
- SMART controllers must be installed at a private residence, rebates will not be issued for controllers installed in multi-family complexes.
- I understand that any SMART controller, for which a rebate is issued, is subject to an on-site installation verification. If installation cannot be verified, the rebate will be denied.
- The Internal Revenue Service requires Rebate Program participants receiving \$600 or more in rebates to be issued an IRS Form 1099.
- The Rebate Program is not responsible for materials lost by mail.

- a valid Colorado identification card;

- a United States military dependent's identification card;
- a United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card;
- a Native American tribal document;
- a birth certificate issued by a state, county or parish;
- a naturalization or citizenship certificate;
- a court-issued adoption order
- an unexpired foreign passport
- an I-94 immigration form with refugee or asylum status; or
- an unexpired resident alien card, permanent resident card, temporary resident card, or employment authorization card.
